**Application is due by December 3, 2021.**

**Winners will be selected and notified by January 22, 2022.**

The Palmetto State School Counselor Association awards five high school seniors a \$1,000.00 non-renewable scholarship to assist with post-secondary education costs.

Eligibility:

Must be a high school senior.

Must be a permanent resident of the state of South Carolina.

Must plan to attend a post-secondary institution during the 2022-2023 school year.

Applicants must:

- Submit an application.

- Complete an essay of no more than 500 words about a school counselor who has made a difference in your academic, career, social, and/or emotional development. You must include your career goals, post-secondary education plans, and an explanation for how this scholarship will help you.

Applicants must be willing to allow their essay to be shared with the school counselor they write about if feasible.

Upload the following documents in this order:

-- Application

-- Transcript

-- Essay about School Counselor

-- Letter of Recommendation

-- Resume

-- College Acceptance Letter (if available)

Note: Prior to receiving funds, scholarship applicants must provide a copy of their admission letter or another form of verification of acceptance to college, university, technical school, or training center.
